Long sleeved, collared shirts, long pants, boots and hat/helmet required for riding classes. Entries allowed 2 gate calls. Entries must be paid before the start of one class preceding the class you are entering. No refunds on entries. NO abusive acts allowed. No training of animals permitted during classes. Owners are responsible for knowing the measurement of their animal. The Show committee will provide a measure stick. No animal will be judged against itself - classes will be combined
We reserve the right to correct any errors on the show bill at anytime prior to the class being held.

- No shavings available on grounds, please provide your own.
