Entries must be paid before the start of one class preceding the class you are entering. No refunds on entries. Unless specified, donkey or mule may enter any class. No abusive acts allowed - you WILL be disqualified! No training of animals permitted during classes. Owners are responsible for knowing the measurement of their animals before the halter and jumping classes. The Show committee will provide a measuring stick. No animal will be judged against itself - classes will be combined. Note the reduction in halter classes and additions of five new classes! We reserve the right to correct any errors on the show bill at anytime prior to the class being held.
