- Animals must be stalled if kept overnight at the Fairgrounds.
- Stalling will be available beginning 4pm on Fri., July 30.
- **Stalls must be cleaned and vacated by noon on Sunday.**
- No shavings available on grounds, please provide your own.
- Primitive camping available. Many motels within 1 mile.

General Show rules: Judge's decision is final. Hard hats are encouraged for exhibitors under 16. Long sleeved, collared shirts, long pants, boots and hat/helmet required for riding classes. Entries allowed 2 gate calls. Entries must be paid before the start of one class preceding the class you are entering. No refunds on entries. NO abusive acts allowed. No training of animals permitted during classes. Owners are responsible for knowing the measurement of their animal. The Show committee will provide a measure stick. No animal will be judged against itself - classes will be combined We reserve the right to correct any errors on the show bill at anytime prior to the class being held.
